

Technical Requirements

This site has been developed and designed to operate under Microsoft's Windows 7 Operating system. The site is tested regularly with a number of different browsers including Internet Explorer **Version 9**, Mozilla Firefox **Version 4.0.1**, Google Chrome Version **11.0.696.68**, Google Opera Version **11.01**, and Apple Safari Version **5.0.3**. At the time of this writing, these are the **LATEST VERSIONS** of these browsers that are available. As new browser versions are made available, we automatically include that browser version in our test pattern. It is our goal to ensure that if you are running Microsoft's latest operating system, properly patched, with the latest version of a browser listed above, you should have no difficulties using www.goldrunnerfractalanalysis.com.

Will the site operate with other operating systems and browsers? The short answer is probably YES, if you have the correct browser and operating system settings in place. But since there are literally thousands of combinations of operating systems, OS versions, browsers and browser versions, we cannot guarantee immediate compatibility with what may be on any particular system or assist in aligning your system to the standards contained herein.

The following factors can affect your ability to access the site:

1. ISP, Firewall & Browser Security

Check your ISP, Router, Firewall and Browser security settings. It is best to include two "allowed" entries in the security tab area of the devices. These are: 1). <http://www.goldrunnerfractalanalysis.com>, and 2). <https://www.goldrunnerfractalanalysis.com>. This configuration setup should allow you to successfully login to the site. Once logged-in, the system displays the user profile. You may make any necessary changes to your profile. Press "Update" to save your changes. Next, to enter the site, click on "I Agree" and click the button "Enter Paid Site".

2. Pop-Up Blockers

Articles in the site either display as linked web pages or pdf files. Both of these generate in a new window, so you must disable ALL pop-up blockers **for the site**. Different browsers act differently when opening a window to display a file. You may need to interact with the browser telling it you want to open the file.

3. Associated files

PC Operating systems maintain a cross-reference table telling the system what program to run when acting on a selected file. You need to have a program on your PC that will read pdf files. That program should be associated with "*.pdf" files in your PC's associated file table. If you do not have such a program, I recommend downloading the free version of Adobe Acrobat Reader for your PC.

4. Download Restrictions

Some browsers have Security / Privacy settings and routinely PROHIBIT downloads. Make sure this is not turned on unless you exempt our site URLs (See #1.)
